

UN Middle East envoy condemns latest suicide bombing near Tel Aviv

10 October – The United Nations Special Coordinator for the Middle East Peace Process, Terje Roed-Larsen, today strongly condemned the suicide bombing attack near Tel Aviv, where an elderly woman was killed and more than a dozen other people injured.

Extending condolences to the victims' families, Mr. Roed-Larsen reiterated that such repugnant terror attacks were legally and morally indefensible and completely counter-productive to peace efforts.

In his statement, released in Jerusalem, the envoy also called on both parties to show restraint and adhere immediately to Security Council [resolution 1435](#) adopted last month.

Among other provisions, that resolution called for a halt to all violence, "including all acts of terror, provocation, incitement and destruction."
