Country Background

- **Fictitious country** with borders with three other countries (N,W,S,) and a coast on the East.
- After years of violent conflict between GOC and rebel forces (MPC, CISC), a **ceasefire** was agreed on 15th May 2016 and a **peace agreement** (Kalari Treaty) was signed on 19th May 2016
- **UNSC Res. 1544** (22 May+3 2016) authorised the establishment of the UNAC under Chapter VII












